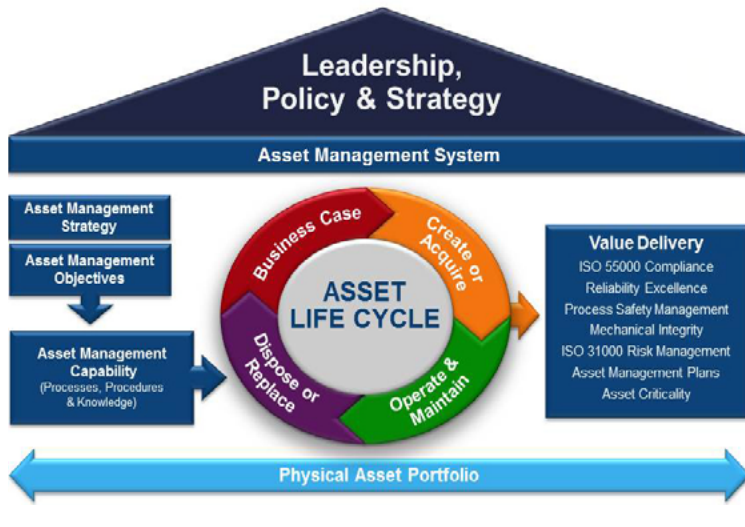


COURSE DESCRIPTION: ISO 55000 for Leaders: Understanding the ISO 55000 Standards



This one-day, virtual workshop will introduce organization leaders to the ISO 55000 set of standards so that they understand their role and responsibilities and are prepared to lead their organization in deploying a risk-based asset management system.

The course uses examples and activities to develop the vision and values needed to guide asset management policy and practices. Participants work with fellow leaders to execute the requirements of the standard and support a world class asset management program.

- Review the components of an Asset Management Policy
- Discuss the context of the organization, including goals, values and vision
- Document stakeholders, guiding principles, and decision-making criteria
- Document reporting and continuous improvement requirements
- Draft an Asset Management Policy communications plan
- Review the components of the Strategic Asset Management Plan (SAMP)
- Define the responsibilities of the individuals who create and maintain the SAMP and the supporting Asset Management Plans (AMPs)
- Discuss what's required to lead the organizational changes
